Pupil Premium Funding

Pupil Premium funding is money which is received by the school annually to improve pupil attainment and to help overcome barriers to learning for disadvantaged pupils.

Pupil Premium Grant Spending 2015/2016

- ◆ Teaching Assistant salary to target specific support and provide interventions for FSM children, including provision for more able.
- ◆ Intensive reading programme, including phonics interventions.
- ◆ Well-being group to provide emotional support.
- ◆ Enrichment opportunities to allow all children to fully access the new curriculum.
- ◆ Booster sessions for Year 6 pupils ahead of SATs to close the gap between disadvantaged and other pupils.
- ◆ Subsidizing of educational visits.
- ◆ ICT provision- purchase of ICT resources to engage and support learning, with a particular focus on disadvantaged boys.
