Communication and Language	<p>This term we will be learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Listen to others one to one or in small groups, when conversation interests us. • Listen to stories with increasing attention and recall. • Respond to simple instructions. • Retell a simple past event in the correct order.
English	<p>This term we will be learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Join in with repeated phrases in stories and anticipate key events. • Suggest how a story might end. • Look at books independently. • Give meaning to marks we draw and paint.
Maths	<p>This term we will be learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use some number names accurately in play. • Recites numbers in order to 10. • Show an interest in numbers in the environment. • Show an interest in shape and space by playing with or making arrangements with objects.
Understanding the World	<p>This term we will be learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Show an interest in the lives of people who are familiar to us. • Remember and talk about significant events in our lives. • Comment and ask questions about where they live or the natural world. • Learn how to operate simple equipment.
Topic	<p>Our Topic this half term is 'Colour my World'.</p> <p>We will be looking at:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • How colour is used during celebration such as Bonfire night, Diwali and Christmas. • Bonfire night party. • Our favourite colours. • Mixing colours. • Colours in our environment. • Stories such as 'Rainbow Fish' and 'Brown Bear Brown Bear What Do You See?' • Colours we see in Autumn and Winter.
Physical Development	<p>This term we will be learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Move freely and with pleasure in a range of ways. • Run skilfully and negotiate space successfully, adjusting speed and direction to avoid obstacles. • Draw lines and circles using gross motor movements. • Use one-handed tools and equipment.

Personal, Emotional and Social Development	<p>This term we will be learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Play in a group, extending and elaborating play ideas. • Initiate play, offering cues for our friends to join us. • Enjoy the responsibility of carrying out tasks. • Show an awareness of our own feelings and know that some actions and words can hurt others' feelings.
Expressive arts and design	<p>This term we will be learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Join in with dancing and ring games. • Sing some familiar songs. • Imitate movement in response to music. • Use movement to express our feelings.
